Those who have successfully completed the said training shall be appointed as Village Fishery Assistant.	The MPEA (Fishery) candidates having qualifications such as Intermediate (Biology) and B.Sc. (Zoology as one of the subject) requires professional knowledge for rendering technical services in the fisheries sector to achieve desired goals. Hence 6 months training programme in the fields of fisheries and aquaculture sector is proposed at State Institute of Fisheries Technology (SIFT), Kakinada/ Regional Training Institutes of Department of Fisheries. Hence the selected MPEA (Fishery) with qualifications in the class (2) requires to undergo 6 months Departmental training. Those who have successfully completed the said training shall be appointed as Village Fishery Assistant.
